## OWNER AGREEMENT

*We are open for drop offs and pick ups from 7:30 am until 6:30 pm 7 days a week, except WE ARE CLOSED FROM 1-4 DAILY.*

- 1) The owner understands that Spring Valley Farm Dog Care (known as SVF and SVFDC) may have multiple trained staff members who care for the dog during their stay. There are several potential boarding locations on the property where dogs may be housed. Changing locations may be required in order to establish compatible co-mingling groups. All dogs receive the same care package regardless of the physical location.
- 2) The owner understands that their pet will co-mingle and have social interactions with other dogs during play and exercise times unless otherwise written or agreed upon.
- 3) The owner understands that their pet will be comfortably crated and taken out a minimum of 5 times a day for adequate durations for potty, play, exercise and human attention.
- 4) **Owner will bring the pet's food. Food will be measured out to include rations for all days of the stay PLUS ONE DAY just in case. DO NOT bring large bins or bags of food, bring only what is needed, we have bins that we need to use, for space reasons. Do not bring a bowl, we need to use our bowls. Failure to bring enough food may result in a fee. Bringing a 40 pound sack of food, for example, when your dog is only staying for 3 days, may also result in a fee. We have to lug everything up & down a long flight of stairs. We also do not have space to store the giant bins or bags of food for 20 dogs, for example. Owner will bring needed medicine, ideally in a weekly pill box. We feed all dogs twice daily: 7:30/8 & 3:30/4. If you pick up at 4, your dog will not be fed supper.**
- 5) Dogs must wear a flat collar; prong/choke collars will be removed by us upon arrival.
- 6) The owner may, and should, provide shock/bark collars if used to manage their dog's barking. We do not allow dogs to bark constantly, as it stresses out all of the other dogs, and us. We have a few collars that we can use, with your permission. Feel free to discuss this with us.
- 7) The owner states that their dog has not shown or displayed any aggressive, overly assertive or fearful behaviors towards other dogs or humans and if so, information has been provided to SVF.
- 8) If a visiting dog bites another dog/human (unprovoked), the owner will assume all liabilities. If provoked, SVF will determine a fair financial arrangement of accountability between the two owners.
- 9) The owner guarantees their dog(s) are on veterinarian-approved topical flea prevention, or a pill, and is free of fleas. Flea collars are not approved, as they are toxic to others.
- 10) The owner guarantees that their dog is free of any contagious diseases, and has not been sick for a 14-day period prior to boarding or daycare, nor been exposed to a sick dog. Should their dog become ill, the dog will be put in isolation or taken to a vet for care.
- 11) The owner gives permission for SVF to seek medical attention if need arises. The owner agrees to pay for any medical fees sought on their behalf by SVF staff.
- 12) The owner agrees that they are solely responsible for any harm or damage caused by their dog to persons or property of the Owners, employees, licensees, invitees of SVF, or any other pets housed or visiting SVF.
- 13) The owner will not hold SVF and any staff or 'handler' responsible for any situation that can arise with dogs and all the things that can occur with dogs whether it is natural, unnatural, unusual, or unexpected.
- 14) The owner recognizes that there are inherent risks of illness or injury when in a co-mingling environment. Such risks include, but are not limited to problems resulting from rough play, colds, diarrhea, etc.
- 15) The owner has provided SVF with all pertinent information on their pet and their care.
- 16) Permission is given to photograph dogs for marketing and compensation is not required.
- 17) **The owner shall always provide SVF with proof of their dog's negative fecal exam dated within the last 6 months or 12 months, as required based on the pill type, per SVF. Owner will also always have the Vet send the records for any vaccinations/boosters given so that SVF has those current records on file at all times. This avoids the situation where you call at 7 on a Friday night and want to board the next day, but you cannot because we have no records on file and/or your dog is not current.**
- 18) **I will always text or email (preferred) or call if I will be late or early for my appointment. Failure to do so may result in a \$25 late/early fee.**
